  - Once on the LogIn Page, click "Add Member". Complete all member information. You must choose one "Volunteer Type" during enrollment. You can always add additional volunteer opportunities later. Once all information has been entered, the system will reflect that you are 50% complete; that is acceptable and therefore please proceed by clicking "Submit".
  - 4hOnline adult status will show as awaiting review.
- □ Complete required "2022-2023 California New Volunteer Training" in eXtension. Go to <u>https://campus.extension.org/enrol/index.php?id=2225</u>. Create a new account, check your email and click on the confirmation link, log into eXtension and click "2022-23 California New Volunteer Training" and enter the code "Sonoma".
